





- 1. Read instructions carefully before
- 2. Only suitable for indoor use.
- 3. Ensure voltage shown on the label match to the mains supply voltage.
- 4. Never let the filter run dry, keep it submerged at all times.
- 5. Disconnect the pump from the mains supply before any maintenance can be made to the pump or aquarium.
- 6. If the supply cord becomes damaged it cannot be replaced; the whole unit should be replaced.

Installation

- 1. Rinse the filter housing and filter cartridge with clean tap water before installing it in the aquarium.
- 2. Fit the suction cups on the rear of the filter housing. Place the filter in the aquarium and use the suction cups to attach it firmly to the side of the aquarium
- 3. Make sure that the pump is completely submerged and located at the correct height (see Fig.1).
- 4. Turn on the filter by plugging the cable into a mains socket.

Maintenance

- 1. The dual-action filter cartridge (Fig.2) contains activated carbon, as well as a foam cartridge, for superior results. Clean the filter cartridge every 1 or 2 weeks by rinsing with water from your aquarium. Never use tap water or any form of detergent.
- 2. Replace the filter cartridge every month (Fig.3). The carbon in the filter cartridge is no longer effective after this time as it becomes fully saturated.
- 3. Replacement cartridges are available at your local Maidenhead Aquatics store.
