Fully automatic and adjustable aquarium heater. Water temperature is full and consistent and heat is evenly distributed throughout. Easy to use even for the novice fish hobbyist.

<u>Safety</u>

Important:

- Always fully submerge Aqua Zonic Eco Heater before connecting it to the mains and switching it on.
- This item is for indoor aquarium use only.
- Ensure heater is always fully submerged and water level does not drop below.
- Before performing water changes, make sure the heater and all other electrical items are disconnected from the mains.
- If the connection lead is damaged, the heater will no longer function and the entire unit will need replacing.

Steps for setting up ECO Aquarium Heater

- 1. Secure the adhesive suckers on to the heater via the clips.
- 2. Set the desired temperature using the temperature control dial.
- 3. Attach Aqua Zonic ECO Heater to the glass aquarium walls using the adhesive suckers.
- 4. For an even spread of temperature select a position where there is the most water movement. For example; near the filter, pump or powerhead. The heater must always be fully submerged in water.

5. When installation is complete insert the plug into the mains. It will take a few minutes to reach the desired temperature. Please note the water temperature may vary from the dial by +/-0.5C.
